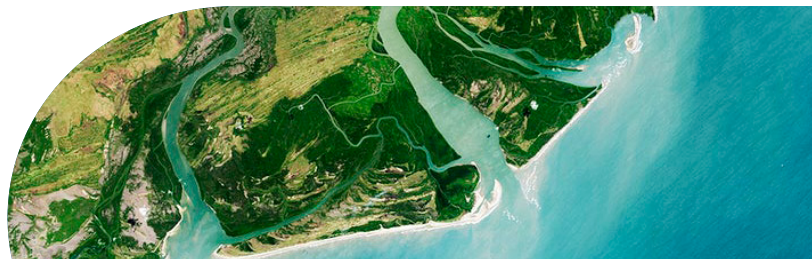
Education and training are specifically tailored for different audiences along their educational journey.
